Re: European Union Directives: 2002/96/EC (WEEE) and 2002/95/EC (ROHS)

As a GE Infrastructure Sensing existing customer, you are aware that we have strong internal programs that meet or exceed environmental regulations of our customers and the regions in which we conduct business. As such, our approach to the European Union Directives 2002/96/EC (WEEE) and 2002/95/EC (ROHS) (the directives) is being addressed in the same rigorous manner.

To ensure timely compliance with the directives, we have already taken the following steps:

- Created a GE Infrastructure Sensing-wide council consisting of a cross-functional team including Technology, Sourcing, Manufacturing, and Environmental Health & Safety, and Sr. Leadership.
- Appointed a leader at each GE Infrastructure Sensing manufacturing site to assure proper implementation of WEEE and ROHS.
- Established an adequate budget and staffing to allow our manufacturing facilities to implement ROHS compliant procedures and processes.
- Maintained close communication with the component manufacturers to understand and promote the availability of compliance components.

Since many of our customers may be impacted by these directives, we intend to make available quarterly updates on our progress.
